BMCC Academic Council Resolutions by Circular (5.03.2020)

The proposal is about Bachelor of Management Science (BMS) Degree Programme in Ecommerce Operations. The Academic Council of Brihan Maharashtra College of Commerce undertakes to verify, approve and implement the BMS Degree Programme in E-Commerce from the academic year 2020-21 by circular.

Preamble: The Logistics Sector Skill Council (LSC) through Ministry for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship initiated the BMS Degree Programme in E-Commerce and forwarded to the Director of Higher Education, Government of Maharashtra. The Director of Higher Education, Maharashtra State, selected Brihan Maharashtra College of Commerce for the degree programme to be started in the Academic Year, 2020-2021. The Principal BMCC constituted the BOS. The BOS meeting was held on Thursday, 27th February 2020 in the library meeting room at 11.00am.

The resolutions by circular to be considered for approval are as follows:

BMCC-ACR-01/05.03.2020: Resolved that the new apprenticeship based course viz. 'BMS Degree Course in E-Commerce Operations' recommended by MHRD and Ministry for Skill Development Entrepreneurship (MoSDE), through Director of Higher Education, Maharashtra State from the Academic Year 2020-2021 is accepted and the principal BMCC be recommended to start the BMS Degree Course in E-Commerce Operations' is hereby approved.

It is further resolved that the Secretary DES be authorized to sign the required MOU with Logistics Sector Skill Council (LSC) (address: Temple Towers, 476, Anna Salai, Nandanam, Chennai-600035) for the same.

Note: The degree structure of BMS Degree in E-Commerce Operations will be of six semesters, which includes General and Skill courses in the first four semesters and Apprenticeship in semester V and semester VI.

BMCC-ACR-02/05.03.2020 :-Resolved that it be recommended to GB(BMCC) that the degree structure recommended by BOS of BMS Degree Course in E-Commerce Operations programme be and is hereby approved. It is further resolved that the code for the BMS Degree Course in E-Commerce Operations programme will be 012.

Note: The syllabus of BMS Degree Course in E-Commerce Operations by BOS of BMS for the academic year 2020-21 (semester I and semester II) is read, revised where necessary and accepted. The code for the course of semester I and semester II will be 012101 up to 012207.

BMCC-ACR-03/05.03.2020 :-Resolved that it be recommended to GB(BMCC) that the syllabus recommended by BOS of BMS Degree Course in E-Commerce Operations programme for semester I and semester II with the code from 012101 to 012207 be and is hereby approved. The detail of course code is hereby attached.

Note: The degree regulations for the smooth functioning of BMS Degree Course in E-Commerce Operations programme comprises of detail guidelines and regulations.

BMCC-ACR-04/05.03.2020:-Resolved that it be recommended to GB(BMCC) that the degree regulations recommended by BOS of BMS Degree Course in E-Commerce Operations programme be and is hereby approved.

Note: The intake capacity for the BMS Degree Course in E-Commerce Operations will be of 60 students and their admissions will be on merit basis decided through the entrance exam.

<u>BMCC-ACR-05/05.03.2020:-</u>Resolved that it be recommended to GB(BMCC) that admissions to the BMS Degree Course in E-Commerce Operations programme to be done on the basis of entrance exam.

Note: The students of BMS Degree Course in E-Commerce Operations will be considered for multiple exits and to reward them the college will bestow them with diploma if required.

BMCC-ACR-06/05.03.2020:-Resolved that it be recommended to GB (BMCC) that the BMCC will adopt the pattern suggested and award diploma /advanced diploma if the student drops out after first year /second year respectively.

Note: The students of BMS Degree Course in E-Commerce Operations have to appear in internal and external evaluation of 40-60 patterns. The internal will comprise of 40 marks and the components for evaluation should include minimum two from the following: Presentation, Group Discussions, MCQs, Home Assignments, Tutorials, Projects, Survey, or any other decided by the teacher in consultation with the college examination officer or coordinator of the course. The internal passing is 20 out of 40 and 30 out of 60 for the external. The external evaluation will be subjective in nature. Thus the students should score minimum fifty percent in order to be eligible for the BMS degree in E-Commerce Operations.

BMCC-ACR-07/05.03.2020:- Resolved that it be recommend to GB (BMCC) that the examination and evaluation pattern recommended by Academic Council of 40/60 be adopted for the programme is hereby approved. Further, the candidates appearing for the examinations should score minimum of fifty percent in both internal and external evaluation in all the courses.






